Award No. 1 – Garden Club Achievement

Certificates with Gold or Blue Seal of Excellence depending on score received

This will be your yearly report for your District Director. She makes her state report from the Award No. 1 applications. She is handicapped in making her report to the state if she does not have your report. If you do no other award, **DO THIS ONE!**

Mail to State Awards Chairman who is the LGCF First Vice President before December 1.

Non-Competitive.

Award No. 2 - Yearbook

No application form necessary - see rules on the LGCF Web Site for Yearbook Chairman, see LGCF Directory on the Web Site . . . Mail to Yearbook Chairman before October 31.

Competitive - According to club size.

Award No. 5-A - Horticulture Paper Award

Certificates based on points earned - Gold seal and Blue seal Certificates issued. See Directory Issue of LGCF on website for details. No application form necessary. Mail before Dec. 1.

Award No. 5-B - Horticulture Honor Roll

For rules and chairman go to LGCF Website. Application form necessary. Download form website listed above. Mail to Chairman before Dec. 1 (Suggestion to Presidents: Assign this responsibility to a club member. Don't wait for volunteers.)

Award No. 11C - Special Conservation Award

A certificate will be given to clubs whose entire membership grows at least one native plant in their garden (This includes trees) - must grow at least five different varieties from the Louisiana Native Plant list. Mail to Chairman before Dec. 1
